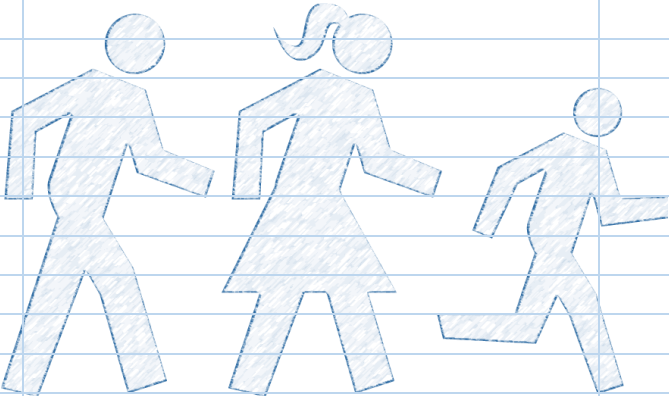
Dear Potential Sponsor,

Saturday, July 8

Our annual car wash-a-thon is a fun and community improvement focused activity for all Concord High Choir Program Students, with all students participating for their personal best. Students set realistic car wash goals and work as a team to reach our goals. Drinks and BBQ lunch will be provided.

Our goal is to help the CHS Choir Boosters raise at least **\$5,000** to fund the **Concord High School Choir Program by washing 100 vehicles within our community for FREE**. We hope that each student will participate in the car wash-a-thon to the best of its ability. If each student raises **\$100**, we will achieve our goal.

All donations will be deposited with the Concord High School Choir Boosters. \$10 from each student's donation will be used to cover the expenses for the event and for their lunches. The remainder will be listed as a credit toward that student's tour account for 2018.

We're hoping to make this car wash-a-thon the best ever, so the more contributions you raise, the more successful we'll be at achieving our goal and serving our community. Thank you very much for your participation!

RULES:

1. Students may start collecting pledges as soon as they receive the pledge sheets. **Reminder: Pledge sheets need to be turned in on car wash-a-thon day, Saturday, July 8.**

2. **Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge per car, and maximum pledge.** Students may collect the pledge in advance but must keep pledges until all are collected.
3. Prior to car wash-a-thon day, 100 free car wash tickets will be distributed by Students and Board Members to our community. On each ticket will be instructions on how to schedule their free car wash. Only cars scheduled to be washed will be washed on Car wash-a-thon day. There will be no un-scheduled washes. On car wash-a-thon day, each student will work during a specified time period in our school parking lot. There will be several stations manned by the students to wash, rinse and dry cars as well as concessions. Each car washed will be posted on our tally board, thereby keeping track of the number of car washes completed.
4. Upon completion of the car wash-a-thon, students receive their pledge sheets back. A volunteer will have recorded the total number of cars washed on their pledge sheet. Students may then collect outstanding pledges. **Please return pledge sheets with the money by August 1st to the CHSCB fundraising coordinator, Rachele Hakes/CHSCB Secretary, Halli Sutton (925)383-4775 or to Mr Emigh's mail box in the main office of CHS, and your funds will be deposited into your account for tour.**
5. Participants are encouraged to wear hats and sunscreen.
